## WB Little League -TBall Division - Special Rules

These are the special rules of the TBall Division as designated by the WBLL. To provide consistency for the players, please follow them throughout the season. They should be shared with coaches and parents, so everyone is fully aware.

Manager and Coaches - Only 4 adults, the manager and 3 coaches, will be allowed inside the fenced area. All adults invited inside the fenced area by the manager must have completed and filed a volunteer form with the HHHLL. Adult assignments are as follows:

## When your team is at bat....

- One adult in the dugout always.
- One adult coaching first base.
- One adult coaching third base.
- One adult catching and instructing the batters.


## When your team is in the field....

- One adult in the dugout always.
- Three remaining adults are on the field to instruct the fielders. Suggested locations would be one on the pitcher's mound and two in the outfield.


## *** Let the kids play. No adult on the field should interfere with a playable ball in any way!

## Lineup

- All players that come to the game should be included in the lineup.
- Late arrivals to the field should be added to the end of the existing lineup and the opposing manager should be told of the addition.
- Lineups should be rotated from game to game to allow all players the opportunity to hit in all places throughout the lineup from top to bottom.


## Batting

- All players must hit off the tee.
- A player bats until he has struck the ball into fair territory. After 5 unsuccessful swings, the coach/catcher will assist the batter in hand over hand fashion.
- An inning ends when every player in the lineup has come to the plate for an at bat.
- There are no strikeouts.


## Baserunning

- Players, both batters and base runners, may only advance one base on any batted ball.
- All players remain on base to run the bases
- No Sliding into any base.
- No Leading off any base.
- No Stealing


## Defensive Positions

- A maximum of 10 players should be in the field - no more than 6 infielders, which includes the pitcher's position.
- Only one player should be positioned on the pitcher's mound.
- Every player should be given the opportunity to play both outfield and infield during a game and the opportunity to play every position during the season.


## Other Rules

- The game length is $45 \mathrm{~min}-1$ hour. Play as many innings as you can in the allotted time and do not keep score.
- No Defensive outs
- No Bunting
- No Infield Fly Rule
