## WB Little League – Minors 9/10 Minors Division – Special Rules

Stealing is allowed ,limit 3 steals per inning, double steals count as 2

Stealing home is allowed

Slide or give them selves up when coming to a base to avoid contact

Bunting is allowed maximum of 2 per inning.

7 runs per innings maximum, no mercy rule

Overthrows are live balls

Play is DEAD when the pitcher has the ball and, on the mound, and asks for time out and its granted by the umpire.

Games are 6 innings no new inning can start after the 1hr and 50 minute mark

All Bats Must Have the USA Logo and the barrel no larger than 2 5/8

Pitching mound is 46ft

Player pitch count and threshold:

## 75 PITCHES PER DAY MAXIMUM pitch count in this division

• The Coach must remove the pitcher when said pitcher reaches the limit of 50 Pitches, Pitcher may remain in the game at another position Exception: If a pitcher reaches the 50-pitch limit while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until that batter reaches base or is put out. Rest rules still apply. Pitcher Rest Rules –

See Separate Pitch Threshold Rules Pitchers league age 16 and under must adhere to the following requirements:

- If a player pitches over 66+ pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed
- If a player pitches over 51-65 pitches in a day, three (3) calendar days of rest must be observed
- If a player pitches 36 to 50 pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 21 to 35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar days of rest must be observed.
- If a player pitches 1 to 20 pitches in a day, no rest is required.

• A pitcher who has pitched 41 or more pitches in a day cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.

• A player who has played in the position of catcher for four (4) or more innings that player cannot pitch for the remainder of that day.

• One (1) pitch constitutes an inning. Each team must carry a pitch counter to every game and supply an adult to record the pitch count. A manager or coach shall confirm the number of pitches

thrown at the completion of every ½ inning. It is the responsibility of the Managers to record all pitch counts for their team and register them online within 24 hours of game completion.
